1. In The Twelve Days of Christmas, what is given on the fifth day?

Answer: Five gold rings

The fifth gift in the traditional carol is five gold rings.

2. Which red-bracted plant is often associated with Christmas?

Answer: Poinsettia

Poinsettias, especially red varieties, are strongly associated with Christmas displays.

3. What is traditionally placed on top of a Christmas tree?

Answer: A star or angel

Stars and angels are the most common traditional tree toppers.

4. Which reindeer is famous for a glowing red nose?

Answer: Rudolph

Rudolph is the title character of the 1939 story and later song.

5. What drink is traditionally made with eggs, milk and spices?

Answer: Eggnog

Eggnog is a rich dairy drink commonly served during the holiday season.

6. Which country is widely credited with starting the modern Christmas-tree tradition?

Answer: Germany

Decorated evergreen trees became a Christmas custom in German-speaking regions.

7. What do people traditionally hang by a fireplace?

Answer: Stockings

Christmas stockings are traditionally hung for small gifts and treats.

8. Which ballet features the Sugar Plum Fairy?

Answer: The Nutcracker

The Sugar Plum Fairy is a character in Tchaikovsky's The Nutcracker.



9. What are the two most common colors associated with Christmas?

Answer: Red and green

Red and green dominate modern Christmas decoration.

10. Which sweet striped candy is shaped like a shepherd's crook?

Answer: Candy cane

Candy canes are traditionally red-and-white and hook-shaped.
