1. Which fruit is traditionally used to make guacamole?

Answer: Avocado

Avocado is the main ingredient in guacamole.

2. What type of pasta is shaped like small grains of rice?

Answer: Orzo

Orzo is a rice-shaped pasta.

3. Sushi is most closely associated with which country?

Answer: Japan

Modern sushi developed in Japan.

4. Which spice gives many curries a yellow color?

Answer: Turmeric

5. What is tofu primarily made from?

Answer: Soybeans
