1. Which vegetable was traditionally carved in parts of Ireland and Scotland before pumpkins became common?

Answer: Turnip

Turnips and similar root vegetables were carved before pumpkins became popular in North America.

2. On what date is Halloween celebrated?

Answer: October 31

Halloween is celebrated on October 31.

3. What phrase do children traditionally say when asking for candy?

Answer: Trick or treat

"Trick or treat" is the traditional phrase.

4. Which animal is often associated with witches in folklore?

Answer: Black cat

Black cats are a familiar Halloween and witchcraft symbol.

5. What is a group of witches sometimes called?

Answer: Coven

A group of witches is often called a coven.

6. Which creature is said to transform during a full moon?

Answer: Werewolf

Werewolf legends commonly connect transformation with the full moon.

7. What do people commonly wear to Halloween parties?

Answer: Costumes

Costume wearing is a central Halloween tradition.

8. What is the name for fear of spiders?

Answer: Arachnophobia

Arachnophobia is fear of spiders.



9. Which orange fruit is commonly carved into a jack-o'-lantern?

Answer: Pumpkin

Pumpkins are commonly carved as jack-o'-lanterns.

10. What sweet treat is made primarily from sugar and often handed out on Halloween?

Answer: Candy

Candy is the classic trick-or-treat giveaway.
