1. Which novel features the character Atticus Finch?

Answer: To Kill a Mockingbird

Atticus Finch is a central character in Harper Lee's To Kill a Mockingbird.

2. Which fictional detective lives at 221B Baker Street?

Answer: Sherlock Holmes

Sherlock Holmes is associated with 221B Baker Street in London.

3. In common English-language teaching, a haiku is usually arranged in how many lines?

Answer: Three lines

English-language classroom examples usually arrange a haiku across three short lines.

4. Who wrote The Hobbit?

Answer: J. R. R. Tolkien

J. R. R. Tolkien wrote The Hobbit.

5. Which novel begins with the character Ishmael?

Answer: Moby-Dick

Ishmael narrates Herman Melville's Moby-Dick.

6. What literary term means a contrast between expectation and reality?

Answer: Irony

Irony often involves a gap between what is expected and what occurs.

7. Who created the character Peter Pan?

Answer: J. M. Barrie

J. M. Barrie created Peter Pan.

8. Which Shakespeare play features Rosencrantz and Guildenstern?

Answer: Hamlet

Rosencrantz and Guildenstern are characters in Hamlet.



9. What is the central character of a story called?

Answer: Protagonist

The protagonist is the principal character around whom the main action develops.

10. Who wrote Frankenstein?

Answer: Mary Shelley

Mary Shelley wrote Frankenstein, first published in 1818.
