1. How many keys are on a standard modern piano?

Answer: 88

A standard modern piano has 88 keys.

2. Which instrument family includes the violin?

Answer: String

The violin is a bowed string instrument.

3. What does tempo describe?

Answer: Speed

Tempo is the speed or pace of a piece of music.

4. Which clef is commonly used for higher-pitched notes?

Answer: Treble clef

Treble clef is commonly used for higher registers.

5. Who composed The Four Seasons?

Answer: Vivaldi

Antonio Vivaldi composed The Four Seasons.

6. Which instrument is played with a bow and held between the knees?

Answer: Cello

A cellist typically supports the cello with an endpin and plays it with a bow.

7. What is a group of three notes played together called?

Answer: Chord

A chord is a group of notes sounded together.

8. Which symbol raises a note by one semitone?

Answer: Sharp

A sharp raises a pitch by one semitone.



9. Which brass instrument uses a slide?

Answer: Trombone

The trombone changes pitch mainly with a telescoping slide.

10. What is a song performed by two people called?

Answer: Duet

A duet is written or performed for two musicians.
