



## Rebus Puzzles With Answers - Answer Key

### Puzzle 1

CYCLE CYCLE CYCLE

**Answer:** Tricycle

**Why:** The word CYCLE appears three times. The prefix tri- means three, so the arrangement reads as tricycle.

### Puzzle 2

HEAD  
HEELS

**Answer:** Head over heels

**Why:** HEAD is placed directly over HEELS, which visually spells the phrase head over heels.

### Puzzle 3

MAN  
BOARD

**Answer:** Man overboard

**Why:** MAN is positioned over BOARD, creating the phrase man overboard.

### Puzzle 4

0  
M.D. Ph.D.

**Answer:** Two degrees below zero

**Why:** M.D. and Ph.D. are two degrees, and both are printed below the zero.

### Puzzle 5

STAND  
I

**Answer:** I understand

**Why:** The letter I sits under the word STAND, so the picture reads I under stand.

### Puzzle 6

YOU JUST ME

**Answer:** Just between you and me

**Why:** JUST is placed between YOU and ME, spelling just between you and me.

## ECNALG

**Answer:** Backward glance

**Why:** GLANCE is written backward, which turns the display into a backward glance.

### Puzzle 8

## JOB IN JOB

**Answer:** In between jobs

**Why:** IN appears between two JOB words, producing the phrase in between jobs.

### Puzzle 9

## ROAD ROAD ROAD ROAD ROAD

**Answer:** Crossroads

**Why:** The ROAD words form a cross, so the arrangement represents crossroads.

### Puzzle 10

## THOUGHT THOUGHT

**Answer:** Second thoughts

**Why:** A second copy of THOUGHT appears beside the first, giving you second thoughts.
