1. How many players from one team are on the field in soccer?

Answer: 11

A soccer team fields 11 players, including the goalkeeper.

2. In tennis, what is a score of zero called?

Answer: Love

In tennis scoring, zero is called love.

3. Which sport uses a shuttlecock?

Answer: Badminton

Badminton players hit a shuttlecock across a net.

4. How many rings are on the Olympic symbol?

Answer: Five

The Olympic symbol has five interlocking rings.

5. Which race is approximately 26.2 miles long?

Answer: Marathon

A standard marathon is 26 miles 385 yards, about 26.2 miles.

6. In baseball, how many strikes usually make an out?

Answer: Three

Three strikes result in a strikeout.

7. Which sport includes the pommel horse?

Answer: Gymnastics

The pommel horse is an apparatus in men's artistic gymnastics.

8. What color jersey is worn by the Tour de France leader?

Answer: Yellow

The overall race leader wears the yellow jersey.



9. Which game uses the terms check and checkmate?

Answer: Chess

Check and checkmate describe threats to the king in chess.

10. How many points is a free throw worth in basketball?

Answer: One

A successful free throw scores one point.
