1. What does CPU stand for?

Answer: Central Processing Unit

CPU stands for Central Processing Unit.

2. Which protocol is used to load most web pages securely?

Answer: HTTPS

HTTPS is HTTP protected by transport-layer encryption.

3. What does GPS help a device determine?

Answer: Geographic position

The Global Positioning System provides positioning and timing information.

4. What is binary code based on?

Answer: Two digits

Binary uses two digits, conventionally 0 and 1.

5. Which component stores data temporarily while programs run?

Answer: RAM

RAM provides fast temporary working storage for active programs and data.

6. What is phishing?

Answer: A deceptive attempt to steal information

Phishing uses fraudulent messages or sites to obtain sensitive information.

7. Which company acquired Android Inc. and became Android's primary steward?

Answer: Google

Google acquired Android Inc. in 2005 and became the primary steward of Android development.

8. What does URL stand for?

Answer: Uniform Resource Locator

URL stands for Uniform Resource Locator.



9. Which device forwards data between networks?

Answer: Router

A router directs packets between different networks.

10. What is two-factor authentication designed to improve?

Answer: Account security

Two-factor authentication requires two different types of evidence before access is granted.
