Answer: Horn of plenty

A cornucopia is also known as a horn of plenty.

8. Which city hosts a famous Thanksgiving Day parade organized by Macy's?

Answer: New York City

The Macy's Thanksgiving Day Parade takes place in New York City.



9. What are people encouraged to express on Thanksgiving?

Answer: Gratitude

Gratitude and thanks are central themes of the holiday.

10. Which vegetable is often baked with marshmallows in a sweet casserole?

Answer: Sweet potato

Sweet potato casserole is sometimes topped with marshmallows.
