1. Which is the largest U.S. state by area?

Answer: Alaska

Alaska is the largest U.S. state by total area.

2. Which river forms part of the border between Texas and Mexico?

Answer: Rio Grande

The Rio Grande forms a substantial part of the Texas–Mexico border.

3. What is the capital of California?

Answer: Sacramento

Sacramento is the capital of California.

4. Which state is known as the Aloha State?

Answer: Hawaii

Hawaii's official nickname is the Aloha State.

5. The Grand Canyon is primarily in which state?

Answer: Arizona

Grand Canyon National Park is in northern Arizona.

6. Which Great Lake is entirely within the United States?

Answer: Lake Michigan

Lake Michigan is the only Great Lake located entirely within the United States.

7. Mount Denali is in which state?

Answer: Alaska

Denali is in Alaska and is North America's highest peak.

8. Which state is made up of two major peninsulas?

Answer: Michigan

Michigan consists of the Upper and Lower Peninsulas.

Answer: Albany

Albany is the state capital.

Answer: Appalachians
